## B. General safety rule

**B.1 IT IS UNLAWFUL TO INSTALL THIS UNIT WITHOUT FIRST**

## OBTAINING A PERMIT FROM THE LOCAL ELECTRICAL INSPECTION AUTHORITY.

- B1.1 Warning: all wiring to the sauna heater and accessories shall be routed away from any direct radiation from the sauna heater.
- B1.2 Warning: any receptacle shall not be installed inside the heated room.
- B1.3 Warning: the sauna heater shall not be subjected to water spray and that shower heads shall not be installed above the sauna heaters.
- B1.4 Warning: No plumbing fixtures(taps, etc) are to be installed in the sauna room.
- B1.5 Warning: the door of the heated room should not include any locking or latching system, malfunction of which could cause entrapment inside the heated room.
- B1.6 Warning: the dry-bath room shall be provided with intended ventilation.

**B.2** Hypothermia occurs when the internal temperature of the body reaches a level several degrees above the normal body temperature of 98.60F.the symptoms of hypothermia include an increase in the internal temperature of the body, dizziness, lethargy, dromsiness, and fainting. The effects of hypothermia include:

- B.2.1 Failure to perceive heat;
- B.2.2 Failure to recognize the need to exit the room;
- B.2.3 Unawareness of impending hazard;
- B.2.4 Fetal damage in pregnant women;
- B.2.5 Physical inability to exit the room;
- B.2.6 Unconsciousness
- B.2.7 Warning-The use of alcohol, drugs, or medication is capable of greatly increasing the risk of fatal hypothermia.

### **B.3 Safety precautions**

- B.3.1 Do NOT dry clothes or leave towels in the sauna.
- B.3.2 Do NOT touch the heater tube with your finger or metal tools.
- B.3.3 Do NOT touch the light when it is on.
- B.3.4 Do NOT splash water or other liquid to the heating tube
- B.3.5 Do NOT use the sauna if you have any of the following conditions:
  - 1) Open wounds, eye diseases or serious burns.
  - 2) Eldly&weak people, especially those suffering from a disease. Pregnant women and infants are prohibited. Children over the age of 6 years may use the sauna under the supervision of adults.

3) Those with heat sensitivity, obesity, heart disease, blood pressure, circulatory system problems or diabetes should consult their doctor **before using**.

B.3.6 Do not place pets into the sauna.

B.3.7 Do not use after drinking excessive alcohol.

B.3.8 This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

B.3.9 Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

B.3.10 Be careful when using the appliance in places where there are combustible materials.

B.3.11 Do not apply to the same place for a long time.

B.3.12 Do not use in presence of an explosive atmosphere.


B.3.13 Be aware that heat may be conducted to combustible materials that are out of sight.

B.3.14 Place the appliance on its stand after use and allow it to cool down before storage.

B.3.15 Do not leave the appliance unattended when it is switched on.

Attention: If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a special cord or assembly available from the manufacturer or its service agent.

## D. Installation

### D.1 Attention the following before installation!

- D.1.1 Do not share the same plug with other appliances.
- D.1.2 Position it on a flat level surface.
- D.1.3 Do not splash the exterior with water. If the floor is damp, install a floor separator to keep the sauna dry & high.
- D.1.4 Do not store the flammable objects or chemical substances near the sauna.

## INSTALLATION DIAGRAM(Inside buckle)




### **D.2 Attention the following during installation !**


D.2.3 Plug in the Bench Heater Cable to the outlet located on the Back Panel. Make sure connection is secure.

### D.4.1 Ceramic Heater:

D.4.1.1 Take off the cover of heater.



D.4.1.2 Take off the ceramic covers of tube and remove the connectors from two ends of the tube.



D.4.1.3 Take off the clip on the bottom part of heater



D.4.1.4 Replace the heater.



D.4.1.5 connect the two connectors to two ends of tube and fasten the ceramic covers of two ends



D.4.1.6 Install the clip on the bottom part of heater cover.

## D.4.2 Carbon fibre heater:


D.4.2.1. Untighten the screws on the carbon fibre heater board and take off the heater board carefully..

## E. Operation

**E.1** In use of sauna room, please point the temperature sensor vertical downward, as shown in the figure below to ensure the accuracy of the temperature display on control panel.

### 1. Original shape




## 2.Vertical downward shape




**E.2** Plug the power cord into the wall outlet.


**E.3** Press the key ON/OFF. The POWER indicator turns on. TEMPERATURE DISPLAY indicates the temperature in the room. Press the key ON/OFF again. The POWER indicator turns off.




**E.4** Press the key F/C , the heat indicator turns on. The sauna will automatically start by pressing the key + or - on the left to adjust the temperature.



**E.5** Press the key IN or OUT to turn on the light in or out of the room. Press them again, the lights will turn off.



**E.6** Press the key + or – on the right to adjust the time . If the time indicates 00, the room stops heating.



**E.7** Open the ceiling vent to allow a flow of fresh if required.

## **F. Tips for use**

**F.1** Set the temperature to a comfortable level, normally 40 to 50°C.

**F.2** Allow approximately 8-15 minutes for the sauna to warm up.

**F.3** Perspiration will begin within 6 to 15 minutes after stepping into the unit. We recommend a sauna session does not exceed 30 minutes.

**F.4** When the temperature reaches the level set on the thermostat, the heaters will turn off and on periodically to maintain the desired temperature level inside the sauna.

- F.5** The front door/window/ceiling vent can be opened at any time to allow fresh air into the room.
- F.6** Drink plenty of water before, during and after a session to replenish lost fluids from the body.
- F.7** Taking a hot shower or bath before the sauna session will further accelerate perspiration. However, do dry off thoroughly before entering, for excessive water will stain or warp the wood. A shower latter is refreshing.
- F.8** To absorb perspiration and keep the sauna tidy, place a towel on the bench and floor of the sauna. Keep one towel handy to wipe out sweat from the body.
- F.9** Utilizing the sauna's heat therapy, put oil into your hair and wrap it with towel. Latter, rinse your hair thoroughly.
- F.10** Massage the affected areas to relieve sore and tense muscles.
- F.11** Shaving your face or legs with a razor while profusely sweating in a sauna yields an incredibly smooth without the use of gels or foams.
- F.12** Do not eat at least an hour before your sauna session. It is better to go in a sauna with An empty stomach. Do not use the sauna immediately after the strenuous exercise.
- F.13** b At the first sign of cold or flu, increasing your sauna sessions may be eneficial in boosting your immune system and decreasing the reproductive rate of viruses.
- F.14** Any area you want to achieve a deep heating should be moved close to the heaters.
- F.15** After the session is over, do not immediately getting out. Let the body sweat a little more. Then, take a warm shower and finish it off with a cold shower to cool off completely.
- F.16** Consult your physician for the proper treatment or any other conditions.

## G. Frequently Asked Questions

### **MAKING SURE SHUT OFF ELECTRICITY BEFORE YOU DOING IT.**

**If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.**

**G.1** The control panel does not work.

**H.1** Clean the sauna room with a soft wet cloth. NEVER use petrol, alcohol, benzene or any other such chemical to clean the unit.

**H.2** In hospital or public use areas the sauna can be detoxified with ultrasonic equipment.

## I. Transportation and storage

**I.1** Avoid exposure to rain, snow or strong collisions during transport.

**I.2** Do not store in damp environments.



## K . Appendix:

### K.1 CD Player Installation



1. POWER BUTTON: Press it to start the power and hold it to turn it off.
2. BAND BUTTON: Press it for FM brand (FM1, FM2, FM3) and AM brand (AM1 & AM2).
3. “VOL+ AND VOL-” For Volume adjustment.
4. MODE BUTTON: CD/RADIO/AUX INTERCHANGE
5. SEL BUTTON: MULTIFUNCTIONAL BUTTON, Press it once for bass, twice for treble, three times for balance (volume balance for the left and right speakers). Hold the sel button to select the mode of music with “DSP OFF” displayed on the LCD, then press “VOL+, VOL-” to select pop, rock, classic, etc.
6. 1/Pause button: Radio (FM/AM) memory/pause.
7. 2/INT button: Radio (FM/AM) memory/browse.
8. 3/RPT button: Radio (FM/AM) memory/repeat play.
9. 4/RDM button: Radio (FM/AM) memory/random play.
10. 5 button: Radio (FM/AM) memory.
11. 6 button: Radio (FM/AM) memory.
12. A./PS button: Auto radio preset channel.
13. ST button: Radio stereo/mono.
14. CLK button: Press it once to display time hold it three seconds to flash out the time, then turn seek+ to adjust minute, seek- to adjust hour.
15. Play/Open button.
16. “Seek+, Seek-” button: On radio mode, press it for manual station search, hold it for

auto station search on play mode, press it for track selection, hold it for fast-forward and fast-backward.

17. MUTE BUTTON: MUTE ON/OFF.

18. AUX: AUXINPUT.



Anion and ozone can only work separately; when the ozone starts to work the anion will stop; after about 15 minutes working the ozone will stop and turn the anion function automatically

**BRIEF INTROUCTION**

**Produce Active Oxygen**

The negative ion generated by ionization of high voltage in the air

is also called Active Oxygen

### **Clear air**

Anions of negative charge can neutralize with the soot and dust of positive charge floating in air resulting in the natural subsidence of them

## K.4 Operation of New Style Control Panel (selected use)


### K.4.1 Plug the power.

Plug the power cord into the wall outlet.

### K.4.2 Turn the key ON/OFF.

Press the key ON/OFF. The Power indicator turns on.

The Temperature Display indicates the real temperature of the room. Press the key ON/OFF again. The POWER indicator turns off.

### K.4.3 Adjust the temperature.


Press the key  $\triangle$  or  $\nabla$  under the temperature display to adjust the temperature. It changes in  $10^{\circ}\text{F}$  or  $5^{\circ}\text{C}$  by each press. The setted temperature will twinkle for 15seconds before returning to the room temperature. Press the key  $\triangle$  and  $\nabla$  together for changing to show from Fahrenheit to Celsius . The highest temperature we can set is  $150^{\circ}\text{F}$  or  $65^{\circ}\text{C}$ , the lowest temperature we should set is more than  $100^{\circ}\text{F}$  or  $40^{\circ}\text{C}$ .

### K.4.4 Adjust the time.

Press the key  $\triangle$  or  $\nabla$  under the Time & EQ display to adjust the time. It changes in 5 minutes for each press. The adjusting time scope is from 5 minutes to 60 minutes.

### K.4.5 Turn on/off the light.

Press the key left or right under the Temperature Display to turn on the light in or out of the room. Press them again, the lights will turn off.

#### K.4.6 Interior Panel

The function of inside panel is almost same with outside panel, the only one difference is just on the inside panel there is a hole for plugging MP3 instead of a power switch . If plug MP3, the music of it can be spreaded out through the speakers of the sauna.

#### K.4.7 Long-time working

If you want the sauna works without time's limit , you can press the key On/Off for 8 seconds, then the display will show 【— —】 instead of any temperature number. Press it again for 8 seconds, it will cancel the long-time heating.


#### K.4.8 Pre-establish time for use.

Press the key  $\triangle$   $\nabla$  under Time&EQ Display together when the power is off ,then the display will show the last time's pre-established time ,then press  $\triangle$  or  $\nabla$  to set the hour you want to pre-establish .After 5seconds ,it will be off in the display, but the time is memorized. It will automatically start to work when it arrives the time you have pre-established. It can be pre-established for 36 hours--1 hour before for use.

#### K.4.9 Open the ceiling vent to allow a flow of fresh if required.

## K.5 Oxygen Ionizer (selected use)

### How to use?

1. Open the fragrance cover(C), load the fragrance box and close the cover.
2. Connect the unit to the power supply.
3. Press the power switch(A) to start.
4. Press the power/function change switch, when the green indicator light is on it is generating negative ions, when red light is lit; it is in the fragrance only mode.



## **1 Key Functions:**

1 **MODE** (Programme mode): Press the button, the program switches between radio (tuner)> CD> USB (MP3)> CD> Radio (Tuner), each function is shown in the display.

2 **MO/ST** : Press the button when the radio is on, to switch between mono and stereo.

3 **TUN-**: When the radio is on, press the button and hold it for 3 seconds, your radio will automatically search for stations from a higher to a lower frequency, press the button in short intervals, you can search the station manually.

4 **TUN+**: When the radio is on, press the button and hold it for 3 seconds, your radio will automatically search for stations from a lower frequency to a higher, press the button in short intervals, you can search the station manually.

5 **PROG / MEM** (program and save): Press the button when the radio is on, then appear 2 digital numbers (transmitter frequency) on the left side of the display. Press TUN+ or TUN- to set your transmitter and then PROG / MEM to save it.

Press the same button when CD / USB are on, your device will switch to the programming and memory function.

Press the button to adjust the time when the unit is off

6 **MUTE** (mute switch): Press the button to turn off all sound while the unit is on.

7 **VOL+**: Press the button to increase the volume when the unit is on.

8 **VOL-**: Press the button to decrease the volume when the unit is on.

9 **STOP**: Press the button to stop playing the CD / USB function

10 **PLAY / PAUSE**: to play or pause the CD / USB function

11 **FAST BACKWARD**: to fast backwards when CD / USB are on

12 **FAST FORWARD**: to fast forward when CD / USB are on

13 **NEXT:** Press the button to select a follow-up title within the CD / USB function

14 **PREVIOUS:** Press the button to select a previous title within the CD / USB function

15 **REPEAT:** In the CD / USB function, press the button once to repeat one song and 2 times to repeat all tracks

16 **EQ:** Press the button to select sound effects.




